

The Schubertiade - world class music making and a relaxing stay in the Austrian Voralberg 25 – 31 August 2017

£1545 per person sharing double bedded room £1620 for a single room £1720 for sole use of a double room

Includes: return flights with Swiss from Manchester, Heathrow or Birmingham to Zurich and private transfers to Bezau, six nights half board at the Gasthof Sonne, one day escorted introduction to the Voralberg & Bregenzerwald, five 1st category tickets for the concerts listed overleaf.

If you've never been to the Schubertiade think of a pretty village (with it's own cablecar) in the Austrian Bregenzerwald, surrounded by beautiful scenery of the Voralberg; a charming family run hotel with excellent food (that Maestro clients have been enjoying for the past 20 years); fresh air, lovely walks, cable cars and wonderful leider recitals and chamber music in Schwarzenberg just 15 minutes away by Schubertiade coach.

The Schubertiade takes place twice each summer in the nearby town of **Schwarzenberg** in the beautiful setting of the **Angelika Kauffman Concert Hall** with concerts at 11am, 4pm & 8pm most days. The local villages have organised an excellent *Schubertiade coach* transfer service for all concerts and you will be transfered from the church in Bezau (just 5 minutes walk from the Sonne) 40 minutes prior to each concert and back again afterwards.

This year we have included five concerts (including two concerts featuring the late Beethoven Quartets with the world renowned Emerson String Quartet; Mezzo-Soprano Elisabeth Kulman with a programme of Schumann, Schubert & Reiter leider; a recital by the outstanding Polish tenor Piotr Beczala accompanied by Helmut Deutsch and finally an Octet of truly outstanding musicians including violinist Baiba Skride, cello & viola players Clemens & Veronika Hagen and on clarinet, Andreas Ottensamer perfoming Antonín Dvořák, String Quintet in G Major, Op. 77 and Franz Schubert's Octet in F major,. Optional concerts include piano recitals with Christian Zacharias (4pm, 27th) and Igor Levit (8pm, 28th) and a leider recital with soprano Marlis Petersen (4pm, 30th). Details are shown overleaf and if you prefer to add or substitute one of these concerts for the five above let us know on your Booking Form.

Gasthof Sonne in Bezau is your base for six nights with direct flights from Manchester and Heathrow to Zurich included as well as private coach transfers from Zurich to Bezau and back. 20kg baggage and reserved seats included.

Die Sonne, in classic Austrian gasthof style, is run by Andrea & Christian Meusburger - the third generation of the same family. The hotel features:

- true single rooms with single bed
- double rooms for sole use
- double/twins for two. Please note that the double/twins are made up with a double bedframe and two mattresses.

Some rooms have balcony (on request only at additional cost). There is a lift to most rooms but some require one flight of stairs to reach them. Porterage of your luggage in and out is included but please let us know if you have any difficulties in respect of the staircase.

Half board is included and dinner is served either early or late to coincide with concert time. The holiday is intended to be an unstructured and relaxing break - ideal for those of you who enjoy the fresh air and great outdoors (or just want to relax in a lovely setting and look forward to glorious music in the late afternoon or evenings).

On the day following arrival we include a full day of sightseeing to give you an 'overview' of the wonderful Voralberg from Bregenz to Lech. After that you have a Bregenzerwald Card giving you free use of ten cable car lines, local swimming pools and the local bus service throughout the area (from as far as Bregenz on Lake Constance to Lech, high in the Arlberg) so that you can make the most of your days.

Ken Grundy will join you for the start of the holiday and Tina Bywater (who has attended more than 20 Schubertiade's) will be our host in Bezau for the full stay and will be pleased to help with tips and advice to make the most of your stay.

Important Note on Deposit payments

For this holiday the deposit is £800 (which includes your £400 ticket subscription which we have to pay immediately to the Schubertiade).

In the event that you have to cancel we will try and resell the entire package but otherwise we can only return your tickets to the Schubertiade for resale but we will not know what has and has not been sold until after the festival has concluded so any refund of resold tickets will occur in September. Any refund of tickets will be less 25% to cover the Schubertiade fees and handling charges.
