



Guys & Dolls at Kilworth; Romeo & Juliet at the RSC and a night at Kilworth House hotel

13 – 14 June 2018

Includes: One night hotel on a bed & breakfast basis, dinner at Kilworth, tickets for Guys & Dolls & the RSC production of Romeo & Juliet and all transfers with light refreshments on the journey home.

For 2018 we are delighted to have been able to secure hotel rooms at the magnificent Kilworth House Hotel so you can enjoy a pre-performance dinner and an evening performance of Guys & Dolls on Wednesday 13th June.

The following morning we have a leisurely full English breakfast before departing for Stratford upon Avon (about an hour's drive) and a matinee performance of Romeo & Juliet at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. We return to the northwest immediately following the performance with light refreshments provided on the journey home.

The cost of staying at Kilworth is of course higher than 'chain' or conference hotels but we believe you will find the superb quality of the accommodation and surroundings to be worth the additional cost. The package including dinner, bed & breakfast at Kilworth, top price seats at Kilworth and front two rows of centre upper circle at Stratford together with all transfers from the Northwest (usual pick up points – see Booking Form) is £355 per person sharing a twin or double room and £435 for single occupancy of a double room.

We have a very limited number of places available so if you would like to join us please call Stacey Friend and she will do her best to reserve a place for you.

The hotel and theatres have strict cancellation policies so that we have to make full payment in advance to secure the tickets (RSC in November and Kilworth by the end of December) so the complete package cost has to be paid in full at the time of booking.

Should you have to cancel, we will only be able to make a refund (less administration charge of £50 per booking) if we are able to resell your place. As we often have a waiting list we would hope that this is not a problem but we cannot guarantee it and we therefore recommend that you are fully insured.
